Pizzeria Antico

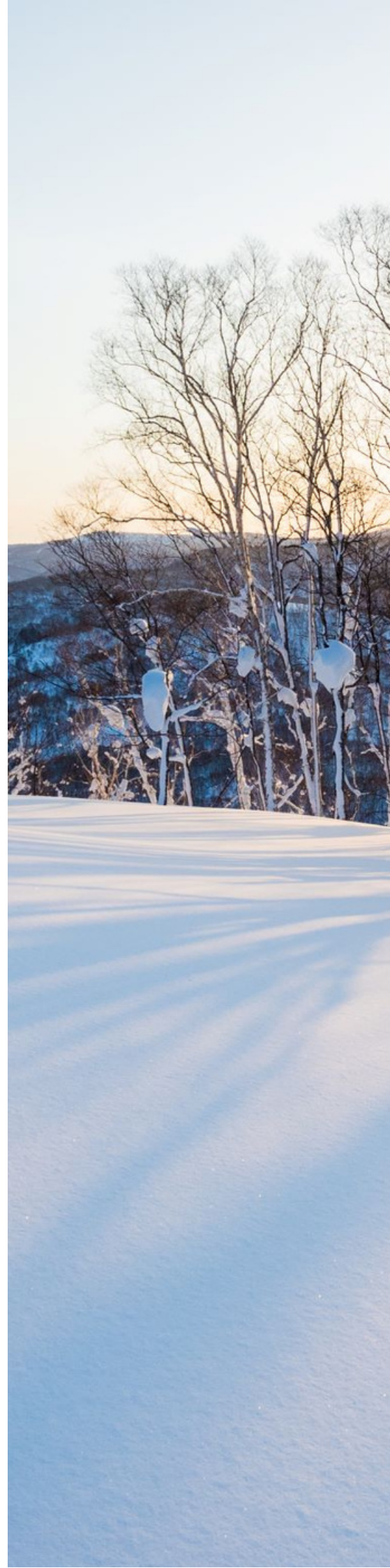
Handmade Neopolitan pizza with the largest selection of craft beer on tap in Whistler. Also serving pasta, starters & salads.

Side Cut

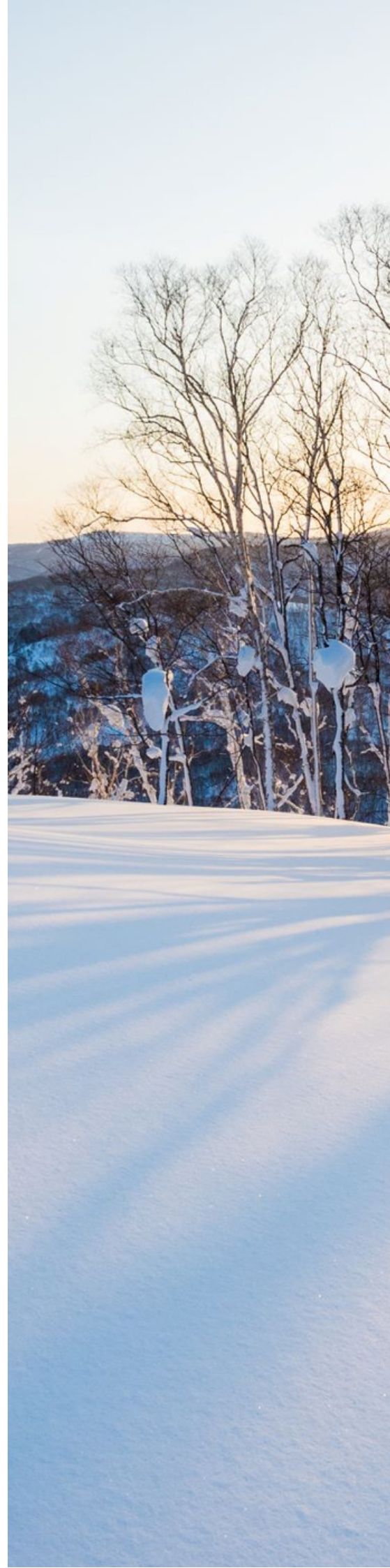
