## **Annapurna**

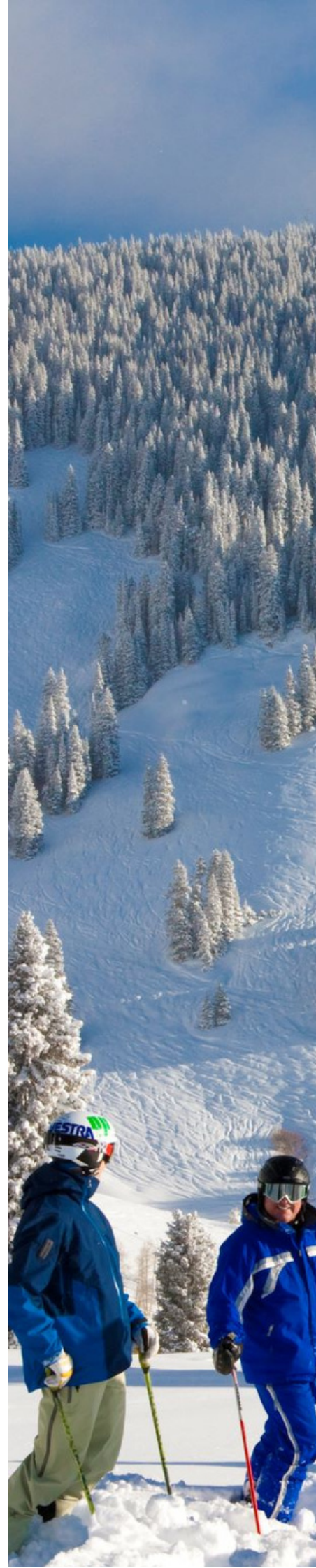
Serving cuisine that combines simple and elegant spices from Nepal and India resulting in dishes rich in flavor as well as culture. Open for lunch and dinner.

## **El Segundo**

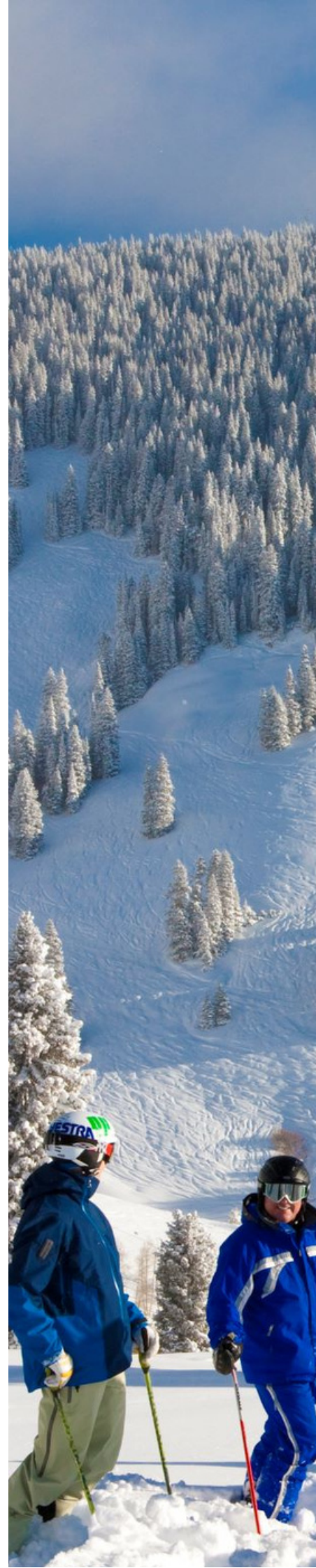
High-energy, fast paced, sophisticated semi-traditional taqueria & tequila bar, located in the middle of Vail Village. Open for lunch and dinner.

## **La Bottega**

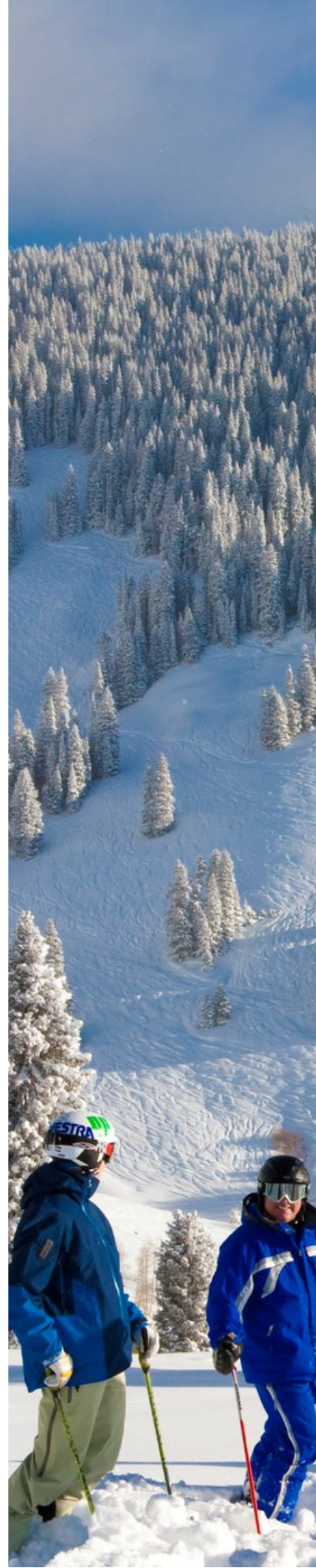

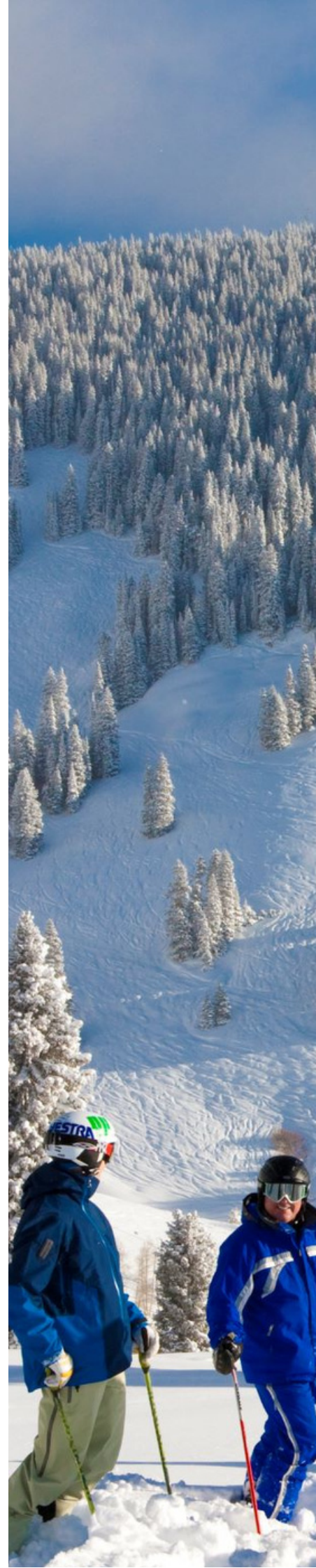

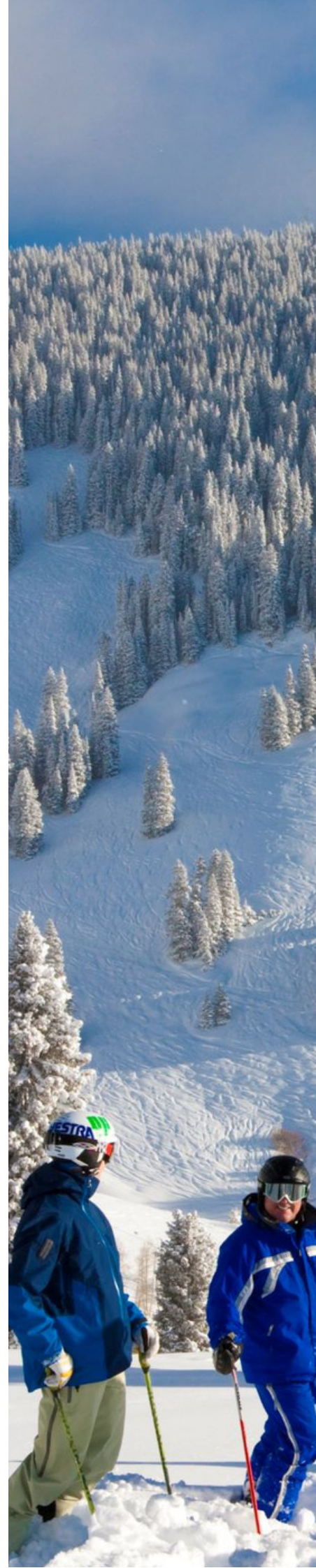

## **Russell's Steakhouse**

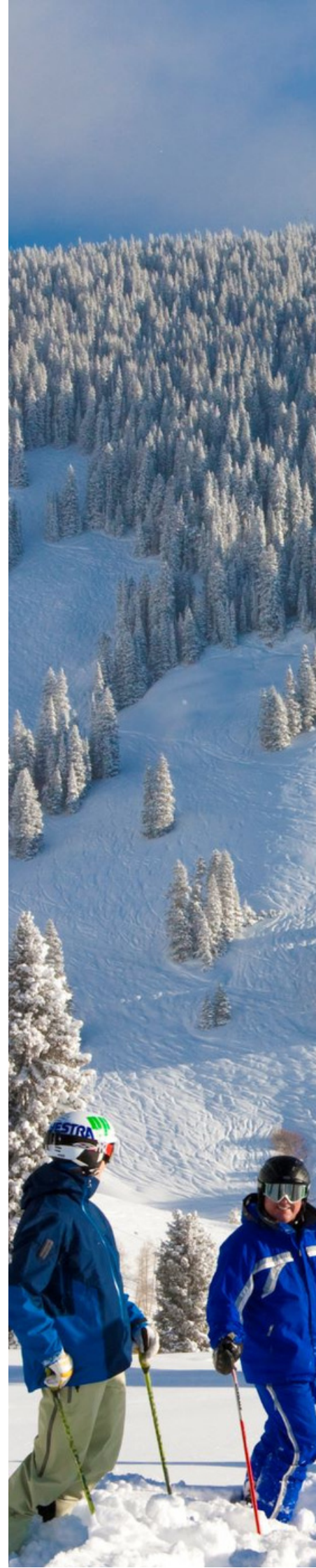
Located in the heart of Vail Village, Russell's serves great steaks and crab legs in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere with a popular bar scene.
