

## **CANADA TRAVELLER REQUIREMENTS**

Below is a guide to assist you in preparing for your snow holiday to Canada

### **PREPARE BEFORE YOU FLY**

#### **1. Download the ArriveCAN mobile app**

You must use ArriveCAN to provide mandatory travel information before and after your entry into Canada.

#### **2. Prepare for Mandatory Arrival Testing and Digital Validation of Health Documents.**

Customers travelling from international destinations (other than the US) in the 14 days prior to their travel can expect further requirements such as arrival testing when they land in Canada. Our travellers (whom have all been non-citizens) have all been tested on landing in Vancouver.

#### **3. To help speed up the process, we strongly recommend our travellers:**

- Upload their vaccine certificate and COVID-19 test results prior to flying to Canada
- Register for the mandatory arrival test before you land, in order to reduce wait times in Canada and continue on your holiday

#### **4. Get Tested on Time**

There are many types of COVID-19 tests. Not all are accepted by a given country, and not all testing entities provide the same tests. Snowscene Travel Advisors will advise the required test and testing time frame for your destination. It is a requirement for traveller's to do their own due diligence and testing requirements prior to their travel.

Snowscene has preferred testing clinics in Australia with Australian Clinical Labs.

ACL is a leading Australian private provider of pathology and as a Snowscene traveller you get \$10 off per PCR test prior to travel, bookings essential.

#### **5. Arrive early for your flight and allow extra time.**

With COVID-19 travel requirements adding extra steps to the travel journey, it is more important than ever that you arrive at the airport on-time for your flight. For check-in and boarding times, please refer to your Snowscene itinerary if flights are included in your package and services provided by Snowscene.

**As at 12 January, 2021**

- You must be a fully vaccinated traveller to enter Canada to avoid a 14 day quarantine period for 12 years and over
- After taking the arrival test when you arrive in Canada you must isolate within 24 hours of landing (*you can travel to your pre-booked ski resort*) for 5 years and older
- Quarantine in a suitable place and await your test result – *Whistler Tourism are allowing clients to check in to their hotel and await their results*
- You can then leave and continue with holiday/travel once negative result is received
